"Follow me: I will make your fishers of men." Whereupon they, leaving their nets and their boat, followed the Lord.


Communion Motet (11:00 Mass)

They lack nothing, those who fear him. The rich suffer want and go hungry, but those who seek the Lord lack no blessing.


Fear the Lord, you his holy ones.




